WELCOME

Allow members to connect with each other before you start with Praise and Worship.

WORSHIP

Sing 1x praise and 2x worship songs.

WORD

Ask a cell member to read the following passage: **Hebrews 1:1-4**

QUESTION 1: What is your understanding of this passage?

Answer:

1. In the New Testament dispensation God speaks to us through His Son.
2. Spirit of prophecy in the church today should put all the attention and focus on Jesus.
3. Everything in the church should point to Jesus.

IF WE IN ANY WAY OR ANY HOW WANT TO EXPERIENCE THE GLORY OF GOD WE MUST LOOK TO JESUS. IF WE WANT TO EXPERIENCE GOD'S GLORY IN OUR MIDST ON A SUNDAY WE MUST LIFT UP THE NAME OF JESUS!

Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: **John 1:1-3, 14; Colossians 1:15-16; John 14:9-11; Philipians 2:9-11**

QUESTION 2: What do we learn about Jesus from these scriptures?

Answer:

1. Jesus alone is the brightness of God's glory
2. Jesus is the express image of the Father
3. His Name stands above every other name and alone is worthy of all the worship, adoration and glory

On Sunday Pastor At mentioned several key concepts we need to never forget when it comes to Jesus:

(Ask a cell member to read each scripture. Ask the cell what each scripture communicates about Jesus before you give them the correct answer.)

- **Acts 4:12; John 14:6** - There is only one Saviour who can save you, His name is Jesus!
- **1 Timothy 2 : 5** - Jesus is the only mediator between God and man
- **Hebrews 4:14-16** – Jesus alone is our High Priest with God
- **1 John 2:1b** – Jesus alone is our Advocate
- **1 Corinthians 8:5-6** – Jesus alone is Lord
- **Isaiah 9:6** – Jesus is the Prince of peace

Ask a cell member to read the following passage: **2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (Message Bible)**

QUESTION 3: If you had to summarize this passage in one sentence, what will it be?

Answer:

“All this comes from the God who settled the relationship between us and him, and then called us to settle our relationships with each other.”

QUESTION 4: What is your understanding regarding the concept of reconciliation?

QUESTION 5: When the Hebrew writer writes that “(God) called us to settle our relationships with each other” which relationships do you think he was referring to?

A LACK OF PEACE WITH GOD AND PEACE WITH PEOPLE DISRUPTS AND DESTABILIZES EVERYTHING IN YOUR LIFE AND BRINGS CONFLICT AND TURMOIL TO YOUR SOUL. THE CENTRAL THEME OF THE GOSPEL IS ONE OF RECONCILIATION:

- PEACE WITH GOD
- PEACE WITH MAN

WE CANNOT HAVE PEACE IF WE ONLY CHOOSE TO RECONCILE WITH GOD AND NOT WITH MAN. THE CROSS RECONCILES US BOTH VERTICALLY AND HORIZONTALY.

Ask a cell member to read the following scripture: **Luke 4:18-19**

QUESTION 6: Jesus said we need to follow Him. This passage in Luke is His declaration of His own life, a life we need to model. How should this passage impact and influence our reconciliation responsibilities?

Answer: Our reconciliation responsibility should result in:

- The poor not being poor no more
- Those who are bound to be bound no more
- Those who carry any burden to be set free
- Those who are sick to be sick no more
