

# HOMECELL NOTES

## PASTOR AT BOSHOFF WHATEVER HE SAYS YOU DO (PART 2) 10 APRIL 2019

### WELCOME

Allow members to connect with each other before you start with Praise and Worship.

### WORSHIP

Sing 1x praise and 2x worship songs.

### WORD

Ask a few cell member to read the following passages: **John 2:1-11; John 9:1-11**

**QUESTION 1:** What are some similarities between these two events?

Answer:

1. In both events the person involved faced a challenging situation
2. In both events Jesus gave a clear word/instruction
3. In both events the person acted on what Jesus said
4. In both events the person experienced a breakthrough

Ask a cell member to read **James 1:22**

**QUESTION 2:** What is the difference between hearing the Word and acting on the Word?

**GOD WILL ALWAYS USE HIS WORD AS THE INSTRUMENT TO ORCHESTRATE YOUR BREAKTHROUGH.**

Ask a cell member to read the following passage: **2 Kings 5:9-14 (with emphasis on verse 11)**

**QUESTION 3:** How should one respond when you receive a word from God that are not making any sense or are conflicting to your expectation?

#### **THERE ARE 2 MAIN THINGS THAT STOP PEOPLE FROM ACTING ON GOD'S WORD**

- an unrenewed carnal mind... unspiritual mindset
- lack of faith... little faith

#### **FIRSTLY – WE NEED TO RENEW OUR MINDS**

Ask a few cell members to read the following verses: **1 Corinthians 2:14; Romans 8:5-8; Hebrews 11:6**

**QUESTION 4:** What do we learn from these scriptures?

Answer: It is almost impossible to act on the Word whilst your unrenewed mind rules your life

Ask a cell member to read **Exodus 6:6-9**

**QUESTION 5:** What was the ONE thing that kept Israel out of their Promised Land?

Answer: v9 - Israel's prevailing mindset that was cultivated in the land of bondage and that controlled their thinking kept them from the Promised Land.

**QUESTION 6:** What practical things must we do to ensure that we'll move from a carnal mindset to a spiritual mindset?

Answer: We need to soak and saturate our thoughts with the Word. (Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: Joshua 1:8; James 1:21-25)

**SECONDLY - IF YOU HAVE A BIG WORD FROM GOD... YOU HAVE TO DEVELOP BIG FAITH MUSCLES!!!**

**QUESTION 7:** On a practical note: How do we develop our faith?

Answer:

1. Time in the Word
2. Communion with the person of Jesus

Ask a few cell members to read the following scriptures: **Romans 10:17; Mark 9:17-29**

**MANY PEOPLE ARE FACING STORMS OR ATTEMPTING GREAT EXPLOITS WITH NO FAITH OR WITH UNDER-DEVELOPED FAITH. WE NEED TO DEVELOP OUR FAITH IN LINE WITH GOD'S WORD BEFORE WE STEP OUT.**

THE MORE TIME YOU SPEND IN THE WORD:

- The more you will see your level of faith grow to the level you need to see His Word fulfilled in your life
- The more your mind will be renewed to think in line with the Word you received

PRACTICAL APPLICATION:

Challenge your homecell to join in a Bible reading plan for at least the remainder of this quarter. The ideal will be to do this until the homecell read through the whole New Testament – make this your goal. Start with Matthew. Challenge each member to read 2 chapters (e.g. Matthew 1 & 2) in the morning and 2 chapters in the evening (e.g. Matthew 3 & 4). Continue until you read through the whole New Testament.
